

Proposed Goals and Plans of Action For SAWC

(draft 2)

- 1). Goal: SAWC will be a consistent visible and public protest against U.S. endless wars.

Plan: Hold monthly protest against U. S. endless wars at the Federal Building in Seattle on the first Tuesday of each month from 11am To 1pm.

- 2). Goal: SAWC will call emergency demonstrations when the U.S. starts or threatens to start a new war or regime change in a sovereign country.

Plan: Create list of peace, anti-war, and community organizations to be Informed of a emergency demonstration of date, place and time to be determined by the SAWC organizing committee(OC).

- 3). Goal: Make MOC's aware of our positions on relevant legislation and have them understand our position and support our position on U.S. wars and relevant foreign policy.

Plan: Plan meeting with MOC's staff periodically and get public to protest and lobby on issues or legislation relevant to stopping U.S. wars or changing foreign policy.

- 4). Goal: Engage the public in understanding U.S. unjust wars and foreign policy.

Plan: Hand out leaflets, have public sign petitions, call or write their MOC and encourage op-eds and letters to the editor.

- 5). Goal: Build a Movement to force the US government to stop interventions and regime change in countries around the world.

Plan: Educate and recruit organizations and individuals to be part of SAWC.
